Forum structure and format

The seventh World Telecommunication/Information and Communication Technology Policy Forum (WTPF-26) will be convened in the Bahamas from **9 to 11 June 2026, with a Strategic Dialogue hosted on 8 June 2026.**

The Strategic Dialogue will provide an opportunity for high-level exchange and will inform the work of the Forum.

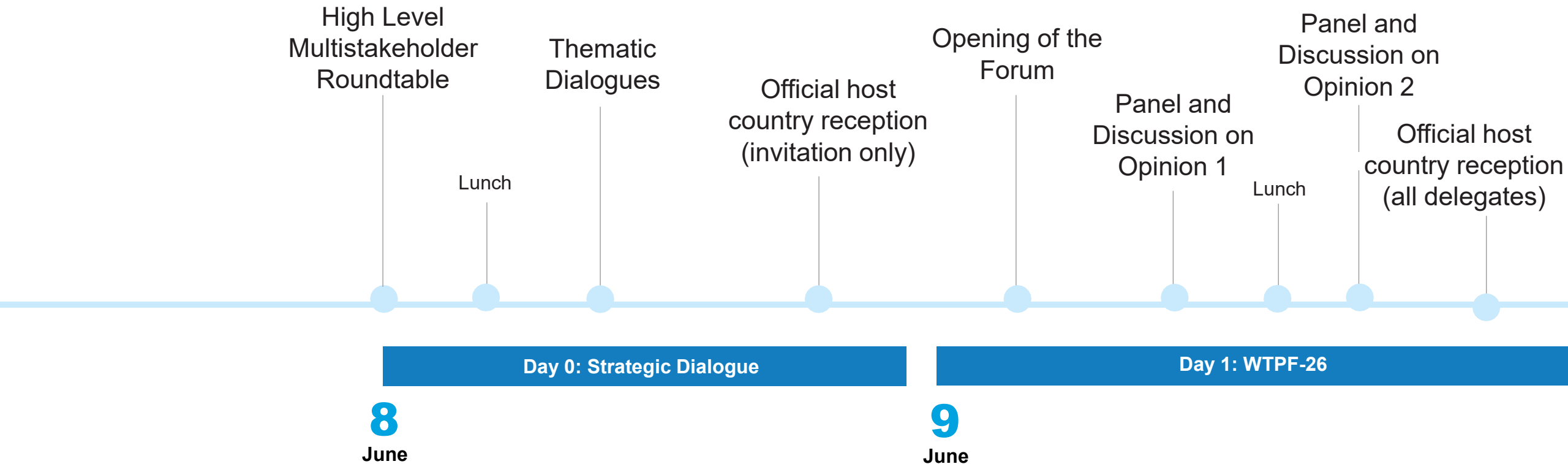
The Forum will open with the inauguration of the WTPF and the organization of the work of the Forum, in accordance with Council Decision 641 and the Rules of Procedure of the World Telecommunication Policy Forum.

For each draft Opinion, the Forum will proceed as follows:

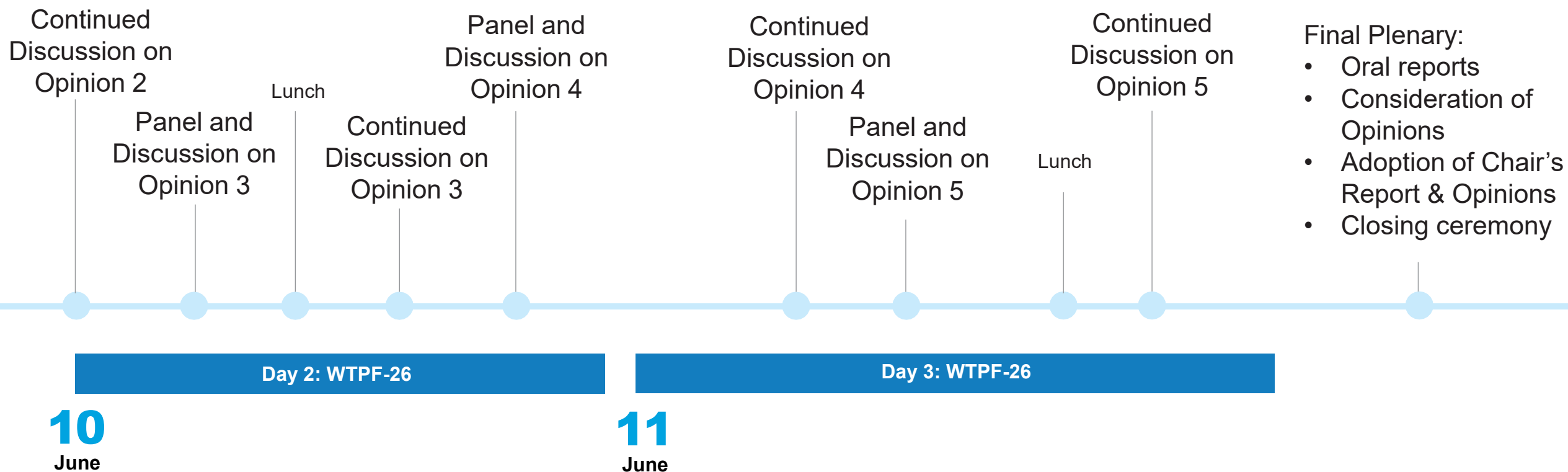
- presentation of the draft Opinion, as reflected in the report of the Secretary-General;
- a short scene-setting panel to provide context for the discussion;
- discussion in plenary, including statements by ministers and VIPs.

The discussions of draft Opinions will span the three days and will follow the order of themes set out in Council Decision 641.

Draft Forum timeline



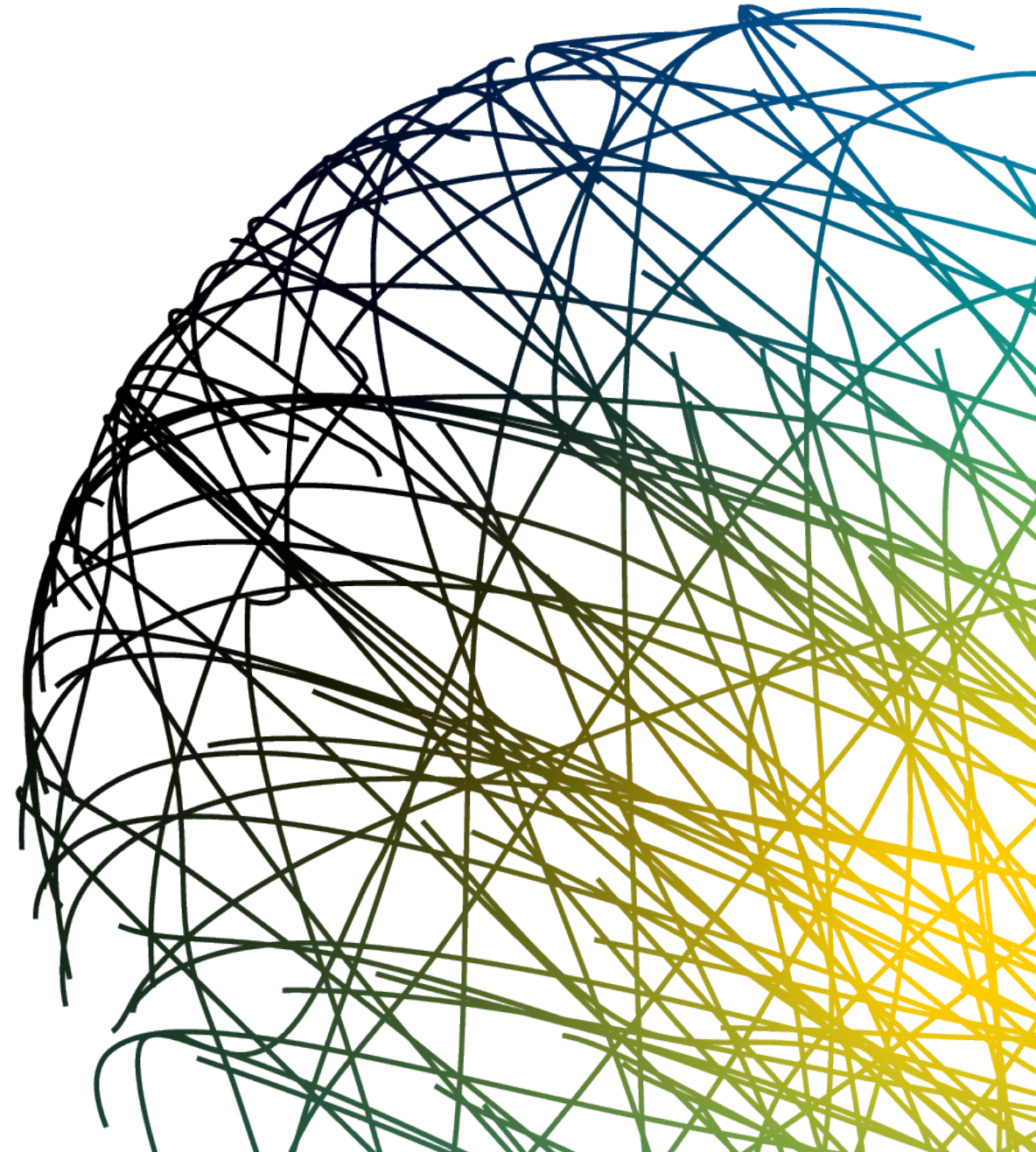
Information on Social Events

Ministerial Participation



Ministerial and VIP-level participation is strongly encouraged at WTPF-26. To support active engagement during the Forum, opportunities for ministers and VIPs will include:

- Participation in the high-level multistakeholder roundtable during the Strategic Dialogue (Day 0)
- participation in scene-setting panels preceding the discussion of draft Opinions;
- the delivery of statements during discussions on draft Opinions;
- Bilateral meetings, organized in coordination with the ITU Secretariat and the host country.

Candidatures for Chair and Vice-Chair



The Forum will elect its Chair and six Vice-Chairs, as well as Chair and Vice-Chairs for the expected 5 thematic Opinion groups of the Plenaries.

Each thematic group has one Chair and one Vice-Chair respectively, representing a Member State and a Sector Member. Women candidatures are strongly encouraged.

As a practice, Chair and Vice-Chairs of the Forum are representatives from the Member States from the six regions. Member States are invited to consult regionally when identifying their candidates to avoid multiple candidates from the same region.

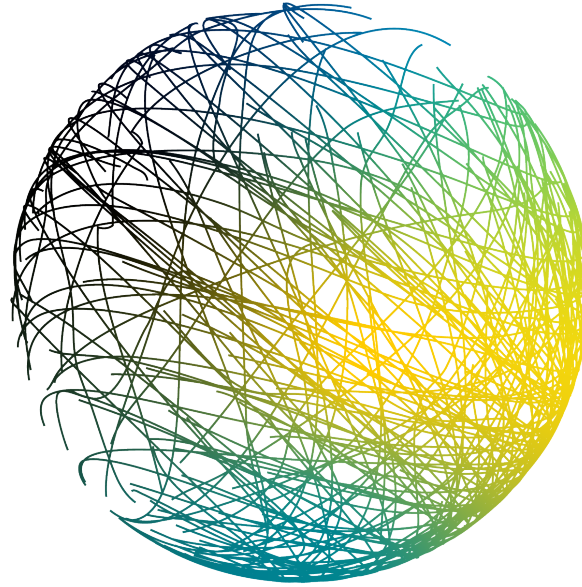

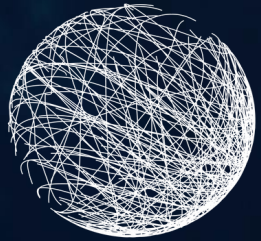

Religious life is predominantly Christian across many denominations, alongside smaller faith communities, with respect, hospitality, and peaceful coexistence forming an important part of the national character.

VISA & ENTRY PROCESS

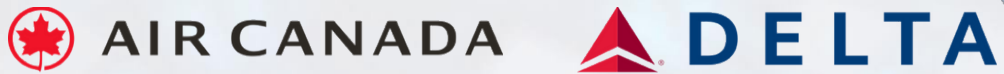
The Bahamas has agreed to waive visa fees for WTPF-26 attendees. However, to benefit from the waiver, visas must be processed through www.wtpf26bahamas.com/ The Visa Application Form can be downloaded from the Host Country Website. Applications will be processed approximately 30 days before the conference
