## **Professional Summary**

Mr. Jones is an economic development specialist by profession with nearly 20 years of experience in the field. Currently he serves as Senior Fiscal Analyst in the Office of the Financial Secretary in the Ministry of Finance focusing on the research, design, development and analysis of government economic and fiscal policy.

Prior to this appointment, he served as Program Manager in the Office of the Prime Minister of The Bahamas, leading the design and implementation of a transformative pilot project aimed at leading development in the inner city of the capital. This project was similarly designed to empower residents and businesses in the inner-city community of New Providence via social and economic empowerment in a sustainable manner. He has and continues to serve in a senior role in many other transformative government initiatives and reforms such as:

- Member of the Economic Prosperity Technical Committee, a collaborative committee created to aid in driving the implementation of economic aspects of the 2030 Sustainable Development Goal agenda locally;
- Member of The Bahamas National Trade Policy Development committee, a multistakeholder team created to aid in preparation of the country's first comprehensive National Trade Policy;
- Former member of The Bahamas' National Development Plan secretariat team, the technical team charged with the drafting and preparation of the Vision 2040 National Development Plan for The Bahamas, outlining a path for sustainable and inclusive development, and
- Member of the Steering Committee for the creation of the Access Accelerator Small Business Development Center, with a focus on meeting the needs of the nation's micro, small and medium sized businesses.

• Senior team member for the engagement to transform the incumbent government legacy electronic communications regulator into a new, modern independent regulator for electronic communications in The Bahamas. Key aspects of the task included assisting in the drafting of an electronic communications sector policy, preparation of a new budgeting framework based on industry fees, organizational structuring, skills mapping and drafting of operating policies.
