Since joining the Federal Telecommunications Institute in 2014, he has been responsible for promoting the mandates and interests of the IFT in the definition of the global policy in ICT and regulations on telecommunications, broadcasting, and economic competition in international organizations, forums, and in collaboration with the Mexican Government in trade negotiations. He was an official in the Ministry of Communications and Transportation for more than six years, where he served as head of the Mexican delegation in various World Assemblies and Conferences, of the ITU, CITELE, and the OECD. Since May 1st, 2021, he was appointed by IFT Acting Chairman, as General Coordinator of International Affairs.

He was Chair of the Preparatory Working Group for World Radiocommunication Conferences to WRC-19 and WRC-23 of the Permanent Consultative Committee II: Radiocommunications of the Inter-American Telecommunication Commission; Vice-Chair of the Telecommunication Development Advisory Group (2011 – 2014), Vice-Chair of the Radiocommunications Advisory Group (2020-2023) and currently is Vice-Chair of the Standardization Advisory Group and Chair of the APEC Working Group of Telecommunications and Information.
