Two Connect Summits will take place in 2012:

- > Connect Arab States: 5 to 7 March in Doha, Qatar
- Connect Americas: 17 to 19 July in Panama City, Panama



Connect Summits aim at mobilizing human, financial, technical and political resources for the implementation of connectivity targets established at the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS):

- ➤ Identify priority **projects** and project holders (in line with ITU Regional Initiatives)
- > Identify and engage potential partners
- Match partners and projects and establish Public-Private Partnerships
- > Get political support at national and regional level

Summit Structure:

- >Experts Meeting
- ➤ Meeting of National Delegations (Heads of State and Governments, Ministers, Heads of Regulatory Authorities)
- ➤ Policy Statements
- > Roundtables
- ➤ Partnership Announcements
- Networking Platform (e.g., VVIP/VIP bilaterals)



The Summits (in Doha and Panama City):

- ➤ Gathering Heads of State and Governments, Ministers, C-level industry leaders, senior executives of regional and international organizations, etc.
- ➤ Roundtables, bilateral meetings, policy statements, press announcements
- > Experts and Ministerial Meetings to finalize selection of projects and partners
- > Summit Communiqué to present way forward and call to action

2015

- Unique global platform to discuss, coordinate and facilitate implementation of WSIS
- WSIS Forum 2011 attracted more than 1,150 delegates, including more than 20 ministers and several senior representatives from private sector and civil society
- **Outcome Document** published on the last day of the WSIS Forum provides strategic guidance

Main objectives of WTSA

- Policies to maintain ITU-T as the most effective venue for international standardization of ICTs
- Identify new work areas and innovative technologies for standardization
- Appoint chairmen and vice chairmen for following four years:
 Official invitation for candidatures
- Decide on issues not resolved in study groups
- Review relations with other bodies to avoid duplication and overlap of work
- Increase participation (especially from developing countries)

- World Conference on International Telecommunications
- Dubai, UAE, 2-14 December 2012
- First event of its kind since Melbourne 1988 Conference which produced the current International Telecommunication Regulations (ITRs)
- Being held at the request of membership to look at ways to revise current ITRs



- 1988 ITRs opened the door for the telecoms revolution of the 1990s
- Now time to take the next step and open the door for the broadband revolution of the next decade
- Updated ITRs focused on light regulation will help us avoid the collapse of ICT networks
- WCIT-12 needs to find win-win solutions to act as a beneficial catalyst for whole ICT sector
