Contributory Unit

- Proposing an increase to ensure financial stability while pursuing efficiency savings and aligning with Member State priorities
- Based on needs, detailed rationale, financial scenarios and is in line with the fact that ITU has not had an increase since 2006
- Contributory Unit would increase by 6.41% from CHF 318,000 to CHF 338,387, if approved by 2025 Council and ITU PP-26
- It would take effect from January 2028
