



• **Development of Ukraine Digital Development Profile** 2024 which will inform the UN's Common Country Analysis for 2024 and will be the foundation of the ITU's input to the 2025 Rapid Damage and Needs Assessment (RDNA) 2025.

Assisting

Towards rebuilding and rehabilitation of the Broadcasting Stations
 As of August 2024, 10 stations have been already assessed, and 10 initial bankable project proposals are currently seeking financial support to kick off the rehabilitation.






