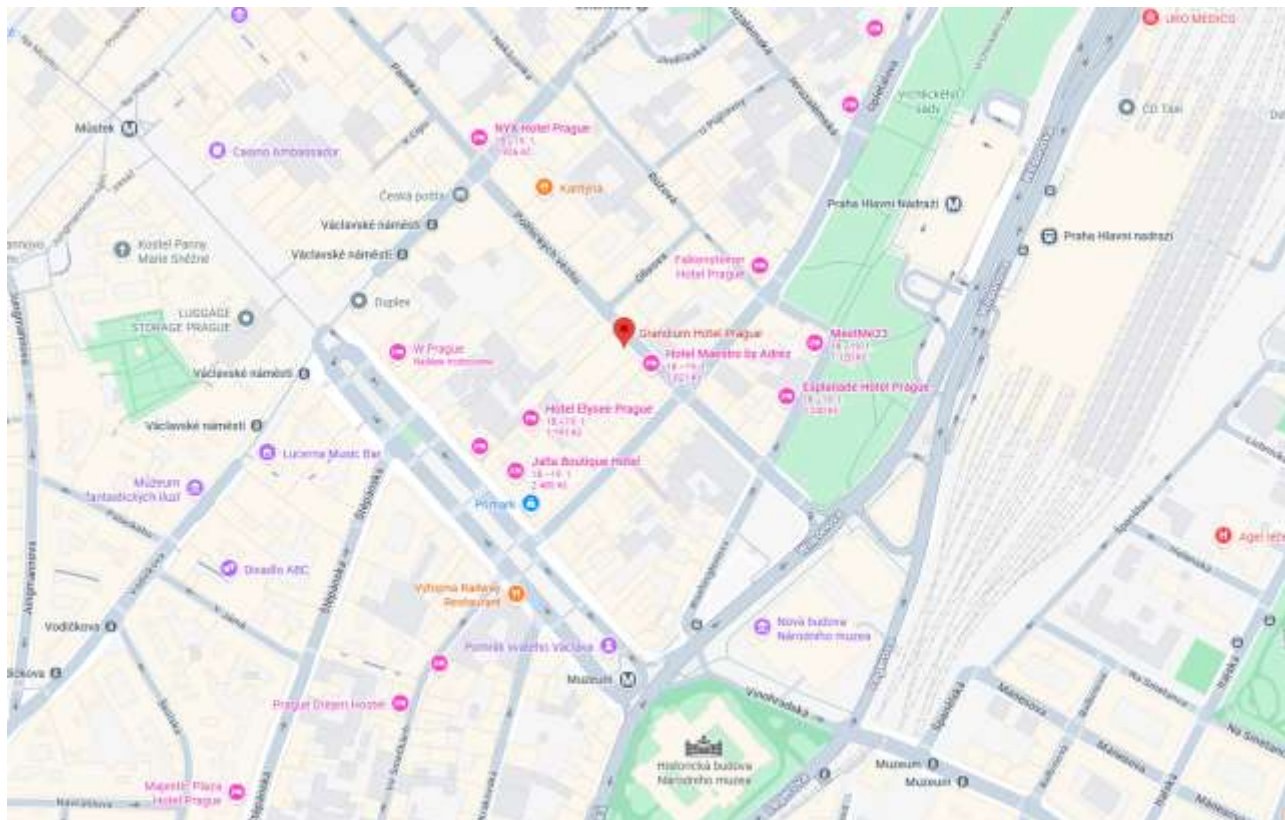

3. Transport

Taxi:

The easiest journey from the Vaclav Havel Airport is by a taxi. There are stands directly in front of the Exit at the airport. You can also use Uber or Bolt.

Public transportation:

Public transportation is possible by the trolleybus and metro. For the shortest route please take the **bus No. 59** (bus stop just in front of Exit, see the picture below) **going to the Nadrazi Veleslavin** (the final stop). There you have to change for the metro line A (green one) going to city centre, station **Mustek or Muzeum**.

Tickets: Public transport tickets must be purchased in advance before the passenger boards the bus. Tickets are sold from ticket vending machines (yellow ones) located throughout both terminals and directly at bus stops. Ticket machines accept contactless credit/debit card payments. **Ticket must be validated inside the bus.** Another option is to buy the ticket inside the bus with orange machine with a contactless credit/debit card.

4. Currency, time, weather

The *currency* is Czech crown (CZK). Most hotels, restaurants, department stores and shops accept major credit cards. If you want to change some money, exchange rate is **1 EUR = approx. 25 CZK**

Time: Local time in the Czech Republic is CET (GMT + 1 hour).

Weather: Czechia has a continental climate with four seasons. In March, Prague is in a transitional period from winter to spring, so the weather is typically chilly and unpredictable, with average daytime high temperatures range from 9 to 14°C and the average night-time low temperature can be around 0°C.

Electricity supply: The European 2-pin electrical plug (complies with European Standards, E or C type, 230 V - 50 Hz)
