To ensure digital inclusion for all our citizens we need to remain focused on our common motivation to move further.

Very recently, on November 11th, Angola celebrated 50 years as an independent country, over these 50 years, several stages have been overcome and gains achieved in the institutional field with regard to policies, regulation and capacity building, in the field of infrastructure, connectivity, digital inclusion, modernization of public administration and cybersecurity.

Our journey has enabled the <u>expansion and modernization of the supporting infrastructure in its terrestrial, submarine, and space components.</u> Has result, our national fiber optic network now we have more than 30.000 km of terrestrial fiber in use. Under our <u>national broadband network project, 4 860 km are beeig repaired and 1.400 Km new fiber being implemented</u>. The angolan owned consortium SACS submarine cable, <u>the first in south of the equator to connect Africa to the American continent</u> (Fortaleza in Brazil) stands has another highlightable milestone.

I would also add that as result of the implementation of Angola's National Space Program, the ANGOSAT-2 satellite was successfully launched and, combined, with mini-solar power plants, and spectrum sharing solutions, its now ensuring connectivity to rural areas. But the greatest success of the program has been the accumulated know-how, training and capacity building, in quantity and quality, of young Angolans who today make us proud with their achievements recognized by the space industry.

Despite the progress made, the number of citizens offline still remind us of a fundamental truth: we cannot close the digital divide if we cannot measure it. And we cannot connect the unconnected if we do not know who they are, where they are, and why they remain offline.

Through, our Integrated Observatory for ICT, and the guidance from the the GIGA project, we have built a robust national dataset that captures multidimensional and georeferenced information with high precision, down to the smallest administrative regional to further promote digital inclusion.
