


EGTI's Mission

The scope of the work of EGTI can be summarized as follows:

- To review existing and develop new telecommunication/ICT supply-side indicators on a continuous basis, including reviewing and developing harmonized definitions and data collection methodologies to keep up to date with the fast-changing nature of ICT technologies and services
- To decide on ICT indicators from the supply side to be collected through the ITU statistical questionnaires on telecommunication/ICTs
- To periodically review the ITU Handbook for the collection of administrative data on telecommunication/ICTs.
- To work with the Expert Group on ICT Household Indicators
 (EGH) on issues related to indicators and topics that are common
 to both groups


