




## 1. Background



The ITU Handbook for the Collection of Administrative Data on Telecommunications/ICT is the **key reference** for the collection of internationally comparable ICT Indicators, based on administrative sources (i.e. supply-side data mainly from operators)



Last revision covering 90+ indicators adopted by EGTI.

**2020-2024:** EGTI adopted **new indicators and revised existing ones**: (e.g., mobile broadband subscriptions and coverage (including IMT-2020/5G, fixed broadband quality of service (QoS), roaming, ICT prices, etc.)



- The ITU Handbook needs to be updated to incorporate the changes.
- Additionally, it would be interesting to publish it in a format that provides direct webbased access to its parts and sections.

#### 2. Aims of the revision 2025

- Add the new indicators adopted by EGTI between 2020 and 2025
  - (including 5G, roaming, QoS) and revise where this had implications for existing indicators (e.g., mobile broadband coverage, subscriptions; fixed network coverage)
- Clarification: Revise or refine existing parts of the Handbook where clarification is needed
  - Provide suggestions for practitioners for data validation and
  - Provide and update methodological details
  - Update examples included for each indicator
  - Remove examples no longer relevant
- Revise the sections where necessary to allow their stand-alone wiki-style publication, while ensuring overall coherence of the Handbook; add cross-references





## 3. Preliminary considerations

- New indicators: only those adopted by EGTI since last revision;
  - ICT Prices: Manual was released in 2025 February
- Clarification: consider number / quality of responses to WTI questionnaires,
  - Provide suggestions for practitioners for data validation and
  - Provide and update methodological details
  - Update examples included for each indicator
  - Remove examples no longer relevant
- Revise the sections where necessary to allow their stand-alone wiki-style publication, while ensuring overall coherence of the Handbook; add cross-references
- Indicative target date: June 2026
