

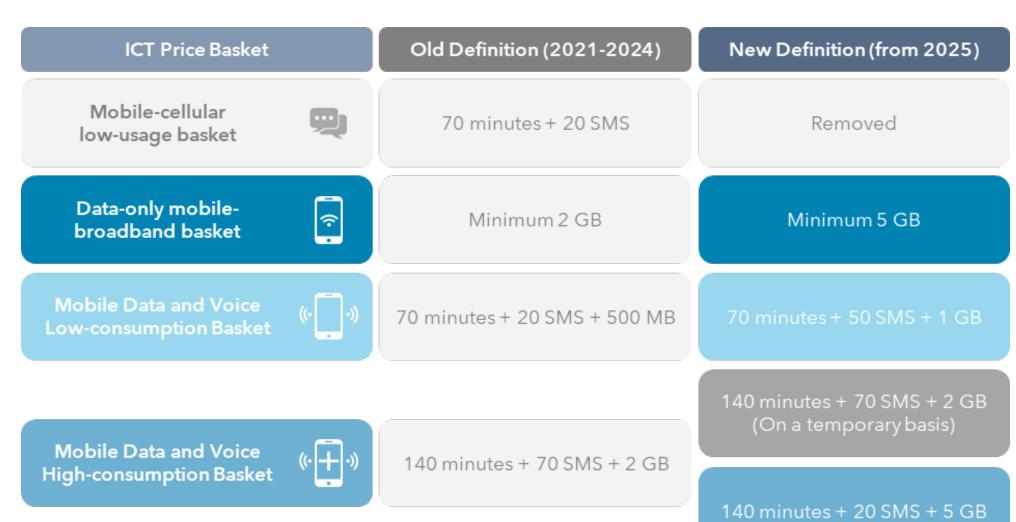

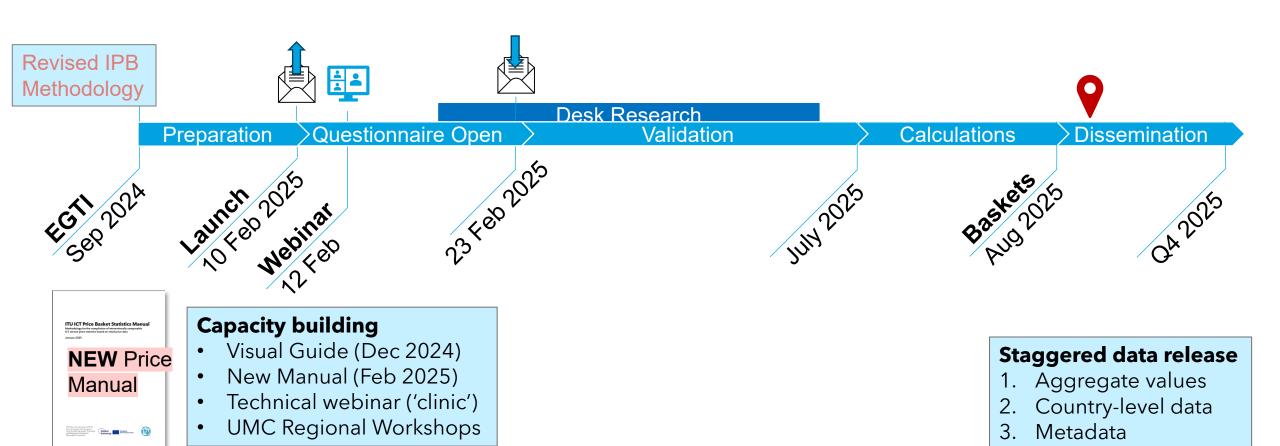

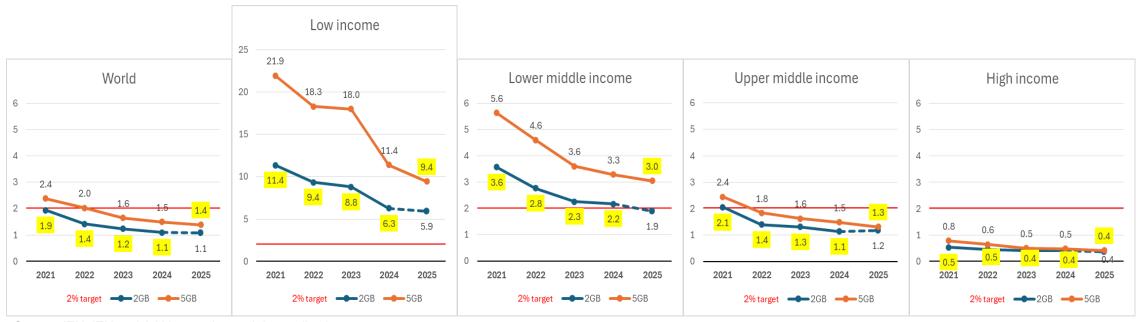
Price statistics for ~200 economies

How to interpret the results?

- Experimental data shows that affordability improved for the 5GB basket
- Pitfall: avoid comparing the affordability of 2GB basket (2024) and 5GB basket (2025)
- Impact on meeting the 2% target: take a forward-looking approach





Conclusions

- Revised data cycle: allows earlier release of results (in parallel: WTI questionnaire)
- Data collection:
 - Capacity building appears to have been helpful
 - Desk research remains essential (filling gaps in metadata + ensure global coverage)
- Validation: larger set of possibilities to consider (prepaid and postpaid plans and addons)
- Calculation: new methodology => update algorithms
- Back office: working new tools for data management (better distinguish plans and compose baskets)
