The scope of the work of EGTI can be summarized as follows:


- To review existing and develop new telecommunication/ICT supply-side indicators on a continuous basis, including reviewing and developing harmonized definitions and data collection methodologies to keep up to date with the fast changing nature of ICT technologies and services.
- To decide on ICT indicators from the supply side to be collected through the ITU statistical questionnaires on telecommunications/ICTs.
- To periodically review the *ITU Handbook* for the Collection of Administrative Data on *Telecommunications/ICT*. The Handbook should be updated to reflect the updated definitions and methodologies.
- To work with the Expert Group on ICT Household Indicators (EGH) on issues related to indicators and topics that are common to both groups.




- For each agenda topic, there is a briefing document containing the summary of the discussions that will guide our discussions. These documents were posted online on the EGTI online forum (see web address below).
