4. Transport and access

Airport: Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport is situated 20 km southeast of the city center, i.e. approximately 50 minutes by minibus/taxi.

Taxi: An official taxi service (Főtaxi) operates at Budapest Airport. You can find the [Főtaxi](#) desk at about 10 meters from the exit of the Arrivals hall.

Shuttle bus: An official airport shuttle service provider for Budapest Airport is [miniBUD](#), offering fast and favorable transfer solutions.

Public transport: Tickets for public transport have generally to be bought in advance. All kinds of tickets can be purchased at BKK Ticket Vending Machines, and [BKK](#) (Budapest Transport Limited) sales offices. The pre-purchased single tickets have to be validated in the buses, trams and underground (metro) stations. A single ticket is usually valid per access in Budapest. An other alternative is BudapestGO Public transport app in Budapest is a new way to get digital tickets, plan your public transport trip easier. [BudapestGO](#) is free to download. However, some features are only available if you register for the app.

5. Visas

The [list](#) contains the countries whose nationals may enter Hungary without a visa for the period and with the travel documents indicated in the list. Citizens of countries not included in the list or holders of travel documents not listed here must obtain a visa from the Hungarian diplomatic mission or consular post of their place of residence or from a diplomatic mission or consular post of a Schengen Member State acting on behalf of Hungary in the country where they are legally resident for a long period (residence permit or equivalent visa).

6. Currency, time, climate etc.

Currency: The currency is [Hungarian Forint](#) (HUF). Most hotels, restaurants, department stores and shops accept major credit cards.

Time: Local time in Hungary is CET (GMT + 1 hour).

Climate: Hungary has continental climate, four seasons. The average high temperature during the daytime is 4°C and the average nighttime low temperature is -2°C. The actual weather conditions are available here: <https://met.hu/en/idojaras/>



Electricity supply: 230 Volts, 50 Hz. The European 2-pin electrical plug/outlet is used in Hungary.
