



In 1997, the Internet and mobile telecommunications were still two distinct industries. It took the boom in mobile communications of 1999-2000 to converge the technologies to bring us to where we stand today, at the dawn of the mobile Internet. These developments, and the technological, policy and regulatory challenges posed by them, have been chronicled by ITU in a series of reports produced within the framework of its commitment to "fully embrace the opportunities for telecommunication development that arise from the growth of IP-based services" (Resolution 101, Minneapolis 1998).

The first three editions looked at "Telecommunications and the Internet" (in 1997), "Internet for Development" (in 1999), and "IP Telephony" (in 2001).

3.3 ITU-R RECOMMENDATIONS

ITU-R Recommendations constitute a set of standards previously known as CCIR Recommendations. They are the result of studies undertaken by Radiocommunication Study Groups on:

- the use of the radio-frequency spectrum in terrestrial and space radiocommunication including the use of satellite orbits;
- the characteristics and performance of radio systems, except the interconnection of radio systems in public communication networks and the performance required for these interconnections which are part of the ITU-T Recommendations;
- the operation of radio stations; and
- the radiocommunication aspects of distress and safety matters.

4.3 ITU-T RECOMMENDATIONS

The ITU-T Recommendations developed by the Telecommunication Standardization Sector (formerly CCITT) constitute the basis for international telecommunication standards. These are the final results of studies on technical, operating and tariff issues with the objective of standardizing telecommunications on a worldwide basis, including interconnection of radio systems in public telecommunication networks and on the performance required for these interconnections. They represent an exceptional reference library of more than 2,500 Recommendations and 60,000 pages.

ITU-T Recommendations are made available individually throughout the four-year study cycle, as soon as they are prepared in ITU-T Study Groups and approved by ITU-T Members. The announcement of each new or revised ITU-T Recommendation is made through the ITU News magazine, the Notifications, and the List of ITU-T Recommendations. There exist three complementary formats of the ITU-T Recommendations available for sale: the paper version, individually downloadable electronic format and the CD-ROM.






