

The sixth edition of *Trends in Telecommunication Reform* examines the various licensing options in the ICT sector to provide regulators with tools they can use to promote effective competition in a converging environment.

The report provides an overview of licensing practices around the world and the rationale for licensing; identifies new trends such as unified licences; provides options; raises transition issues to be considered in moving from one regime to another; evaluates traditional licensing models; addresses scarce resources such as spectrum; and identifies best practices. The report is structured into eight chapters.



Dans la 6^e édition des *Tendances des réformes dans les télécommunications*, on analyse les différentes possibilités d'octroi de licences dans le secteur des TIC afin de donner aux régulateurs les moyens de promouvoir une concurrence efficace dans un environnement marqué par la convergence.

Ce rapport, en huit chapitres, donne un aperçu des pratiques en matière d'octroi de licences dans le monde entier et de leur raison d'être, présente les nouvelles tendances telles que les licences unifiées, formule des solutions, rappelle les éléments à prendre en compte lors de la transition entre deux régimes, évalue les modèles traditionnels d'attribution des licences, pose le problème de la rareté de ressources telles que le spectre et définit les meilleures pratiques.

En la sexta edición de *Tendencias en la reforma de las telecomunicaciones* se consideran las diversas opciones para la concesión de licencias en el sector de las TIC con miras a ofrecer a los reguladores instrumentos que puedan utilizar para promover una competencia eficaz en un entorno convergente.

El Informe contiene un panorama general de las prácticas de concesión de licencias que se utilizan en todo el mundo y de las razones fundamentales de las mismas; se identifican nuevas tendencias tales como las licencias unificadas; se ofrecen opciones; se plantean problemas de transición que han de considerarse al pasar de un régimen a otro; se evalúan los modelos tradicionales de concesión de licencias; se consideran los recursos escasos tales como el espectro y se identifican las prácticas más idóneas. El Informe está estructurado en ocho capítulos.


