The ITU-R Recommendations constitute a set of international technical standards developed by the Radiocommunication Sector (formerly CCIR) of ITU. They are the result of studies undertaken by Radiocommunication Study Groups on:

- the use of a vast range of wireless services, including popular new mobile communication technologies;
- the management of the radio-frequency spectrum and satellite orbits;
- the efficient use of the radio-frequency spectrum by all radiocommunication services;
- terrestrial and satellite radiocommunication broadcasting;
- radiowave propagation;
- systems and networks for the fixed-satellite service, for the fixed service and the mobile service;
- space operation, Earth exploration-satellite, meteorological-satellite and radio astronomy services.

The ITU-R Recommendations are approved by ITU Member States. Their implementation is not mandatory; however, as they are developed by experts from administrations, operators, the industry and other organizations dealing with radiocommunication matters from all over the world, they enjoy a high reputation and are implemented worldwide.

The ITU-R Recommendations are available in Adobe Acrobat Portable Document Format (PDF). The collection is indexed in order to allow full-text search and retrieval. Advanced search can be made through each document's title, subject domain, author or Study Group and keywords.

The ITU-R Reports contain technical, operational or procedural statements prepared by a Radiocommunication Study Group on a given subject. They are scanned and saved in Adobe PDF. Search can be made only through a document's title, subject domain, author or Study Group and keywords.

Current technical requirements are PC i486™ or Pentium®-based processor or compatible, running Microsoft® Windows® 98, Windows® Me, Windows NT® 2000, Windows XP® Professional or Home Edition, with 64 MB of RAM (minimum) and CD-ROM drive. However, the formats and structure of this publication may be modified to reflect changes in electronic publishing technology.
