The Space Radiocommunications Stations on CD-ROM is a service document published in electronic format by the Radiocommunication Bureau (BR) pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Article 20 of the Radio Regulations. It contains alphanumeric and graphical information on satellite networks and earth stations, which are provided to and maintained by BR.

The software (SPACEQRY) allows the user to access the data (in an MS-Access Version 97 database) by such criteria as space station/earth station name, orbital position (or range of orbital positions), space station/earth station administration, country, geographical coordinates, class of station, assigned frequency (or range of assigned frequencies) and category (coordination/notification). It permits the user to navigate within the set of data retrieved, to print some or all of the data and to export an extracted subset to an MS-Access database. The related graphical data (consisting of diagrams for the antenna gain contours, service area and the gain towards the geostationary orbit) can be viewed through GIMS, either through the alphanumeric information retrieval software or independently.

The CD also contains software developed by BR for the electronic notification and validation of satellite networks/earth stations; SPACECAP allows the capture of satellite networks/earth stations parameters which can be validated via the "SPACE VALIDATION" software, SPACEPUB allows for the printing of satellite networks and earth station, GIMS allows the capture of the related graphical data (mentioned above) and the carrying out of power-flux density calculations, SPS is used to analyze the Space Plans (Appendices 30, 30A and 30B), GIBC to carry out Appendix 8 (29) and power-flux density calculations, SPACECOM for assisting administrations commenting on CR/C special sections and software to determine the coordination area around an earth station according to Appendix 7.

Methods of payment

All publications ordered from ITU must be paid for in advance. Payments can be made:

Payments normally should be made in Swiss francs (CHF). Payments may also be made in other currencies, freely convertible into CHF, provided that, when converted by the bank, the price of the service in CHF is covered. ITU does not accept Letters of Credit.

For faster order processing, we invite you to either pre-pay by credit card or take advantage of a new service by opening an ITU deposit account.

Forms of dispatch

The catalogue price includes the cost of dispatch by non-registered economy-class mail or the means of carriage most advantageous to ITU. Dispatch can be requested in other forms: i.e. airmail, DHL, Federal Express, TNT, UPS or diplomatic pouch. If one of these alternative methods is chosen, the dispatch cost will be added to the quote. As from 1 February 2003, the costs of shipping via registered mail have been added to the economy-class costs. You may, if you wish, refuse these conditions but, in this case, ITU will not be held responsible for the replacement of any undelivered orders dispatched by mail that has not been registered. Any discrepancy or claim must be communicated to ITU within one year of dispatch of the publication(s).

Return of publications
