Предмет: Пересмотренные формуляры для представления патентных заявлений и

лицензионных деклараций

В Административном циркуляре СА/148 (15 апреля 2005 года) содержались формуляры, используемые для представления в МСЭ-R патентных заявлений держателями выданных патентов или ожидающими решения по заявкам на патенты, при этом эти формуляры были приведены в соответствие с формулярами, используемыми в МСЭ-Т. В результате последующих совместных обсуждений с Международной организацией по стандартизации (ИСО) и Международной электротехнической комиссией (МЭК) формуляры были вновь пересмотрены и приведены в соответствие с формулярами всех четырех указанных организаций. Эти новые формуляры, приложенные к настоящему Циркуляру, заменяют прежние формуляры, содержащиеся в Административном циркуляре СА/148 от 15 апреля 2005 года, и их следует применять с 30 сентября 2006 года.

Следует отметить, что нет необходимости вновь представлять данные, которые уже содержатся в Базе данных по патентным заявлениям. Указанные новые стандартизированные формуляры следует использовать только для представления новых патентных заявлений.
