Subject: First meeting of the Working Party of the Regulatory/Procedural Group (RPG) in
preparation for the RRC-06 and the associated short conferences

As well as announcing the first meeting of the above-mentioned Working Party, Administrative Circular CACE/319 contains information on the programme of the meeting, citing relevant Resolutions from RRC-04 and providing a draft agenda.

At the request of the Chairman, RPG, we wish to draw attention to two particular issues that require study and for which contributions to the Working Party of the RPG would be welcome. These issues are, namely:

- Equitable access (referred to in § 5.1.2 of the Annex to Resolution 1 (RRC-04) - Report from the first session of the conference to the second session),
- Transition period (referred to in § 7.4 of the Annex to Resolution 1 (RRC-04) - Report from the first session of the conference to the second session).

As a consequence, these two items will be included in the work programme of the Working Party and placed under item 4 of the draft agenda given in Annex 1 to CACE/319.
