**Subject:** Radiocommunication Study Group 9

- Adoption of 4 new Recommendations and 1 modified Recommendation by correspondence and their simultaneous approval in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (Procedure for the simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence)
- Suppression of 2 Recommendations

**Fixed service**

By Administrative Circular CAR/173 dated 25 October 2004, and its Addendum of 24 November 2004, 4 draft new Recommendations and 1 draft modified Recommendation were submitted for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), following the procedure of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (§ 10.3). Two Recommendations, (ITU-R F.1492 and F.1493), were also proposed for suppression.

The conditions governing these procedures were met on 24 January 2005, with two Administrations responding in favour of the adoption, approval and suppression of the respective Recommendations.

The approved Recommendations will be published by the ITU and Annex 1 to this Circular provides their titles, with the assigned numbers.
