Addendum 1 to Administrative Circular CAR/182 8 February 2005

To Administrations of Member States of the ITU

Subject: Proposed simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence of 6 draft new

Recommendations and 3 draft revised Recommendations developed by

Radiocommunication Study Group 6

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 6, held on 4 November 2004, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 6 draft new Recommendations and 3 draft revised Recommendations by correspondence (§ 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4) and further decided to apply the procedure for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4. Enclosed with this letter are the draft Recommendations in the remaining working languages of the Union*, in accordance with your response to Administrative Circular CA/129, Annex 2 (Request for ITU-R circulars and related documents).

In accordance with the provisions of § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4, the consultation period will end on <u>8 April 2005</u>. If within this period no objections are received from Member States, the draft Recommendations shall be considered to be adopted by Study Group 6. Furthermore, since the PSAA procedure has been followed, the draft Recommendations shall also be considered as approved. However, if any objection is received from a Member State during the consideration period, the procedures given in § 10.2.1.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 shall apply.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of the PSAA procedure shall be announced by Administrative Circular (CACE) and the approved Recommendations published as soon as practicable.
