#### To Administrations of Member States of the ITU

**Subject:** Radiocommunication Study Group 1

 Proposed adoption of 2 draft revised Recommendations and their simultaneous approval by correspondence in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5 (Procedure for the simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence)

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 1, held on 26 and 27 June 2008, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 2 draft revised Recommendations by correspondence (§ 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5) and further decided to apply the procedure for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), (§ 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5). The titles and summaries of the draft revised Recommendations are given in Annex 1.

The consideration period shall extend for 3 months ending on 22 October 2008. If within this period no objections are received from Member States, the draft revised Recommendations shall be considered to be adopted by Study Group 1. Furthermore, since the PSAA procedure has been followed, the draft Recommendations shall also be considered as approved. However, if any objection is received from a Member State during the consideration period, the procedures given in § 10.2.1.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5 shall apply.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of the PSAA procedure shall be announced in an Administrative Circular (CACE) and the approved Recommendations published as soon as practicable.
