**To Administrations of Member States of ITU**

**Subject: Radiocommunication Study Group 1**

- **Proposed approval of 1 draft new Recommendation and 1 draft revised Recommendation**
- **Proposed suppression of 1 Recommendation**

At the meeting of ITU-R Study Group 1 (Spectrum management) held on 24 and 25 September 2009, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 1 draft new Recommendation and 1 draft revised Recommendation by correspondence, according to § 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5. Furthermore, the Study Group proposed the suppression of 1 Recommendation.

As stated in Circular Letter 1/LCCE/86, dated 30 October 2009, the consultation period for the Recommendations ended on 30 December 2009.

The Recommendations have now been adopted by Study Group 1 and the approval procedure of Resolution ITU-R 1-5 § 10.4.5 is to be applied. The titles and summaries of the Recommendations are given in Annex 1. The Recommendation proposed for suppression is listed in Annex 2.

Having regard to the provisions of § 10.4.5.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5, you are requested to inform the Secretariat ([brsgd@itu.int](mailto:brsgd@itu.int)) by 20 April 2010 whether your Administration approves or does not approve the draft Recommendations.

A Member State who indicates that the draft Recommendations should not be approved is requested to advise the Secretariat of the reason and to indicate possible changes in order to facilitate further consideration by the Study Group during the study period (§ 10.4.5.5 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5).

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of this consultation will be notified in an Administrative Circular and arrangements made for the approved Recommendations to be published in accordance with § 10.4.7 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5.

Any ITU member organization aware of a patent held by itself or others which may fully or partly cover elements of the draft Recommendation(s) mentioned in this letter is requested to disclose such information to the Secretariat as soon as possible. #### **DVB-T coverage measurements and verification of planning criteria**

This Recommendation describes methods for DVB-T coverage measurements and their evaluation.

Draft revision of Recommendation ITU-R SM.1753

#### **Method for measurements of radio noise**

The current version of Recommendation ITU-R SM.1753 includes methods to measure radio noise but is limited to the white Gaussian noise component only. This revision of the Recommendation is based on latest knowledge in this complex field and describes how to measure and evaluate all components of radio noise including impulsive noise.
