Subject: Radiocommunication Study Group 4

- **Proposed adoption of 4 draft revised, 2 draft new Recommendations and their simultaneous approval by correspondence in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (Procedure for the simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence)**
- **Proposed suppression of 3 Recommendations**

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 4, held on 17 and 18 November 2005, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 4 draft revised and 2 draft new Recommendations by correspondence (§ 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4) and further decided to apply the procedure for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), (§ 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4). In accordance with the interim procedures recommended by the RAG at its meeting in November 2004*, the draft Recommendations in English, as revised at the meeting of Study Group 4, are enclosed with this letter. Furthermore, the Study Group proposed the suppression of 3 Recommendations (ITU-R S.1065, ITU-R S.1066 and ITU-R S.1067).

The consideration period shall extend for 3 months ending on 27 April 2006. If within this period no objections are received from Member States, the draft Recommendations shall be considered to be adopted by Study Group 4. Furthermore, since the PSAA procedure has been followed, the draft Recommendations shall also be considered as approved. However, if any objection is received from a Member State during the consideration period, the procedures given in § 10.2.1.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 shall apply.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of the PSAA procedure shall be announced in an Administrative Circular (CACE) and the approved Recommendations published as soon as practicable.
