Subject: Implementation of Appendix 30B in accordance with Resolution 149 (WRC-07)

4. Circular letter CR/302 of 19 May 2009

To the Director-General

Dear Sir/Madam,

- 1. In the Circular letters referenced 1 to 4 above, the Radiocommunication Bureau informed administrations of the actions which had been taken to implement Resolution 149 (WRC-07), especially the status and schedule to develop and test the necessary software for application of technical examinations under Appendix 30B (Rev.WRC-07).
- 2. Since then the Bureau has processed pending submissions under Article 7 of Appendix **30B** received before and after WRC-07 and has resumed the examination of submissions received under Article 6 of Appendix **30B**. Annex 1 to this letter shows the statistics of Appendix **30B** submissions to be treated under §6.1 up BR IFIC 2667 of 20.04.2010.
- 3. In accordance with *resolves* 6 of Resolution **149** (WRC-**07**), administrations were invited to review their submissions, with a view to reducing their number, and were requested to indicate to the Bureau the networks which were no longer required to be considered and processed under Article 6 of Appendix **30B** (Rev.WRC-**07**). The Bureau reminded administrations of this invitation in its Circular letter referenced 1 above. The Bureau has received a fairly encouraging response with some administrations responding positively by requesting the deletion of obsolete submissions. Despite this effort, the number of Article 6 submissions is still numerous and may not correspond to the real requirements of administrations.

By cooperating in these efforts to employ the scrupulous and diligent application of the principles and provisions of the ITU Constitution, Convention and Radio Regulations, you will allow reducing, and to the extent possible removing, the obstacles impeding the development and bringing into operation of new satellite networks in Appendix 30B.


