To Administrations of Member States of the ITU

Subject: Adoption of 1 draft new Recommendation by Study Group 1 by correspondence and its simultaneous approval in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (Procedure for the simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence)

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 1, held on 18 and 19 October 2004, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 1 draft new Recommendation by correspondence (§ 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4) and further decided to apply the procedure for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4. Enclosed with this letter is the draft new Recommendation in the remaining working languages of the Union, in accordance with your response to Administrative Circular CA/129, Annex 2 (Request for ITU-R circulars and related documents).

In accordance with the provisions of § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4, the consultation period will end on 22 January 2005. If within this period no objections are received from Member States, the draft new Recommendation shall be considered to be adopted by Study Group 1. Furthermore, since the PSAA procedure has been followed, the draft new Recommendation shall also be considered as approved. However, if any objection is received from a Member State during the consideration period, the procedures given in § 10.2.1.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 shall apply.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of the PSAA procedure shall be announced by Circular Letter (CACE) and the approved Recommendation published as soon as practicable.

Any ITU member organization aware of a patent held by itself or others which may fully or partly cover elements of revised Recommendation(s) proposed for adoption is requested to disclose such information to me, in no case later than the date scheduled for adoption of the Recommendations in this Circular Letter. The “Statement on Radiocommunication Sector Patent Policy” is contained in Annex 1 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4.
