Subject: Meetings of Working Parties 6A, 6B and 6C in conjunction with a meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 6

WP 6A: Terrestrial broadcasting delivery

WP 6B: Broadcast service assembly and access

WP 6C: Programme production and quality assessment

Following the eruption of the volcano in Iceland last week, most European airports including Geneva have been closed to air traffic since Friday 16 April 2010. As a result, the participants to the meetings of the Study Group 6 Working Parties who come to Geneva by air, were unable to be present for the start of the meetings on 19 April 2010. It was therefore decided to delay the start of the Study Group 6 Working Party meetings by one week, to Monday 26 April 2010. Since the end of the block of meetings was scheduled for Friday 30 April 2010 and it was not possible to extend this date for various reasons (start of JTG 5-6 and the Study Group 5 block meetings), the Study Group 6 Steering Group has agreed that only Working Parties 6A and 6B will meet from 26 to 30 April 2010 and that the meetings of Working Party 6C and Study Group 6 will be cancelled for this block of meetings.

This decision to delay the start of the Study Group 6 block meetings could be reviewed further, depending on the evolution of the situation and the re-establishment of air travel in Europe.
