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Report by the Secretary-General

WORLD SUMMIT ON THE INFORMATION SOCIETY

Summary

The first phase of the Summit took place in Geneva on 10-12 December 2003 and preparations are underway for the second phase of the Summit in Tunis from 16-18 November 2005.

Action required

The Council is invited to take note of this Report.

Financial Situation

- 1 The Summit is organized with the support of voluntary financial and in-kind contributions. The UNGA has not provided any funding for WSIS.
- According to Table 3 of C04/25(Add.1) submitted to the last Council session, it was estimated that the core activities of the Tunis Phase of the Summit would cost approximately CHF 15 million in addition to the services and facilities provided by Tunisia. Since the outset of the Tunis Phase, the Executive Secretariat has made every effort to limit expenditures through the efficient use of resources and by seeking in-kind support by various stakeholders. For example, by hosting PrepCom-1 in Hammamet, the Government of Tunisia made various in-kind contributions, which minimized expenses incurred by the WSIS Trust Fund. Likewise, the hosting of PrepCom-2 by the United Nations in Geneva also led to substantial savings for the WSIS Fund. PrepCom delegates provided additional financial savings by shortening the term of the second meeting from ten to seven days. The United Nations Office at Geneva also provided facilities and support for meetings of the Group of the Friends of the Chair, which would have otherwise generated additional unplanned costs for the WSIS Fund. On the other hand, the WSIS Fund will incur greater costs in certain areas due to ITU's financial and human resource constraints and the large physical distance between ITU headquarters and the host country, which together limit the flexibility of the ITU to absorb such costs within its normal operations. These factors account for an estimated CHF 421,000 in additional expenditures to be covered by the WSIS Fund.

- Considering the estimate of CHF 6,028 million presented to the Council in June 2004 (Document C04/25 (Add.1)), and the new estimate of CHF 5,427 million, net savings of CHF 601,000 are expected in cash for all the phase of preparatory pocess and the Summit, provided that there are no additional meetings between Prepcom-3 and the Summit
- To raise contributions for the Tunis Phase, the Secretary-General launched a dynamic fundraising campaign. The objective is to raise at least CHF 5 million in financial contributions, with the remaining CHF 10 million in expenses to be covered by in-kind contributions. Thus far, there has been a positive response, as 58% of the CHF 5 million goal has been raised (See details in Table 2).
- According to Decision 6 (Marrakesh, 2002), the ITU 2004-2007 Financial Plan includes an appropriation of CHF 1,194,000 for the Summit. In this respect, Resolution 1222 of the Council made available an amount of CHF 597,000 planned for 2006-2007 to the 2004-2005 budget, through a withdrawal from the Reserve Account, with provision for repayment into the Account from the 2006-2007 budget.
