The WSIS+10 preparatory process is and open and inclusive process, providing a platform for consultation among all WSIS Stakeholders (governments, private sector, civil society, international organizations and relevant regional organizations). The WSIS+10 MPP aims at developing multistakeholder consensus on two draft Outcome Documents.
