Invitation to submit 20-year stakeholders report on the implementation of WSIS outcomes

Dear Sir/Madam,

The World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) process remains at the forefront of leveraging the power of digital technologies for sustainable development. United Nations General Assembly Resolution 70/125, adopted as the outcome document of the WSIS+10 review, requested the General Assembly to convene a high-level meeting in 2025 to conduct an overall review of the implementation of WSIS outcomes ("WSIS+20"). The resolution underlines the need for inclusive input and participation of all stakeholders in the preparatory process, with the objective of taking stock of achievements, identifying ongoing priorities and challenges, and contributing to the review of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

In line with the implementation of ITU Council Resolution 1334 on the ITU Role in the Overall Review of the Implementation of the Outcomes of the World Summit on the Information Society, and following the discussions held during the 42nd meeting of the ITU Council Working Group on WSIS&SDG, all stakeholders are encouraged to compile a WSIS+20 Report to highlight their achievements, challenges, and trends in implementing the WSIS Outcome documents over the past twenty years.
