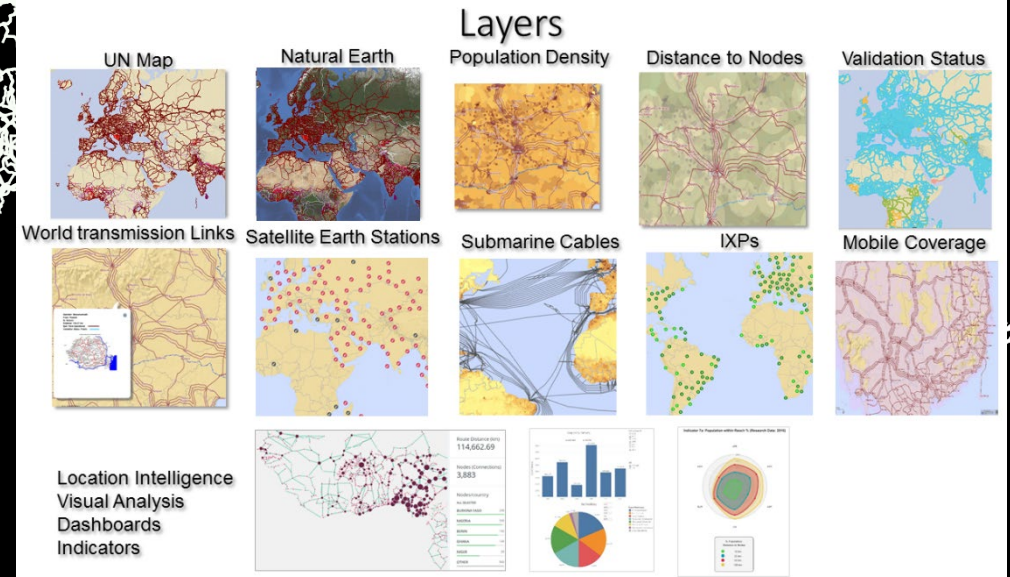
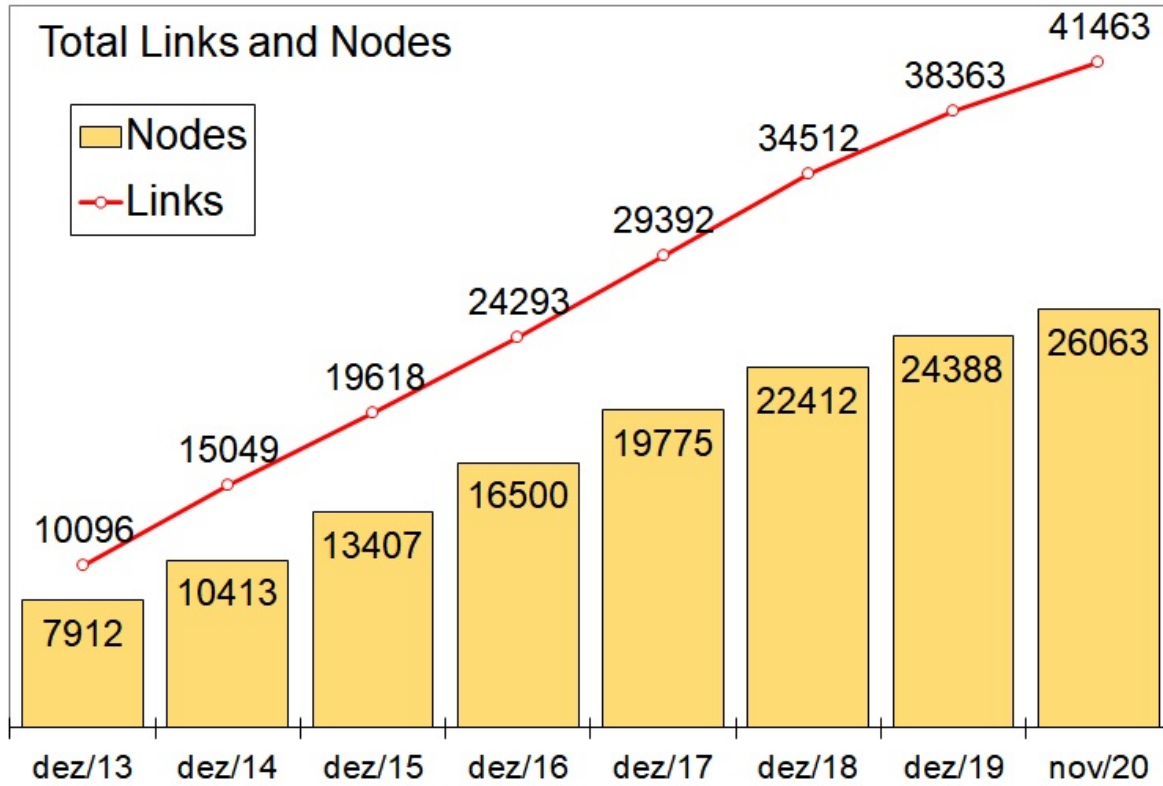


ITU Broadband Maps

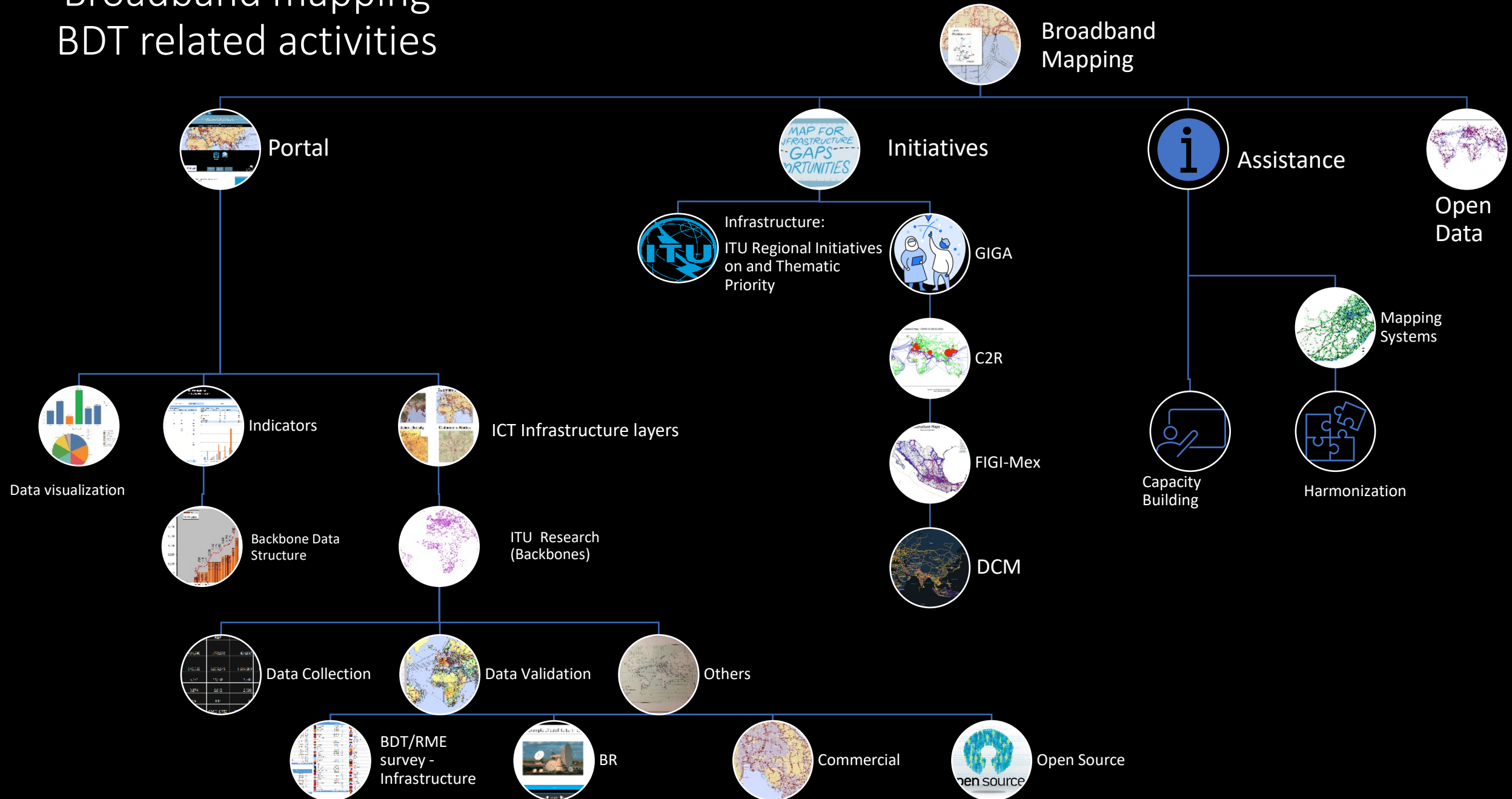

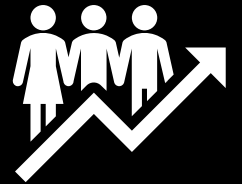


Regional Associations

– Key drivers for harmonized approach –

Collecting relevant **information** on national mapping systems (type, scope, use):

- increases knowledge of what NRAs/Ministries are doing to identify connectivity gaps and attract investments.
- provides the basis to advance regional or subregional harmonization initiatives and opportunities for cross border collaboration



Establishing **relationships** at the country level with the relevant focal points in charge of broadband mapping

- opening up to possibilities for activities in this domain, such as:
 - setting up working groups
 - exchanging best practices
 - discussing challenges
 - addressing international connectivity



Example from Europe

ITU Regional Initiative for Europe on ICT infrastructure:

- The primary goal is not only to ensure that existing **gaps are not widening** but act to **avoid that new ones are not created**

Country engagement

- 35+ national mapping systems identified and categorized

Report

- Report on Regional Harmonization Initiatives elaborated (link to [background Report](#)) based on European Commission and BEREC work and various experiences of countries

Community

- 35+ focal points established
- Regional workshop to gather the community of experts, exchange national best practices and address regional harmonization

Engagement with ITU

- Letter of Engagements signed with 6 countries (and additional 3 in the pipeline) formalizing collaboration with the ITU on provision of accurate backbone data for the ITU broadband maps



Regulatory Associations may consider partnering with ITU in this process
