Underline 3 aspects

- 1) Mandatory *Monitoring methodology* to the PT entities
 - What do the entities need to do? What are we asking for?

Monitoring methodology

(What are we asking for? Our minimum order)

3 different types of evidences / efforts / levels:

A) Automatic check in a sample that consists of:

- Homepage + All links connected to the Homepage + 1 page per template (*websites*)
- 1 page per template (*apps*)

B) Manual check based on a functional checklist in a sample that consists of:

- Pages that allows to answer to the diversity of items of the functional checklist (*websites* and also *apps*)

C) Usability tests w/ People with Disabilities

- Minimum with 1 task and 1 type of functional limitation

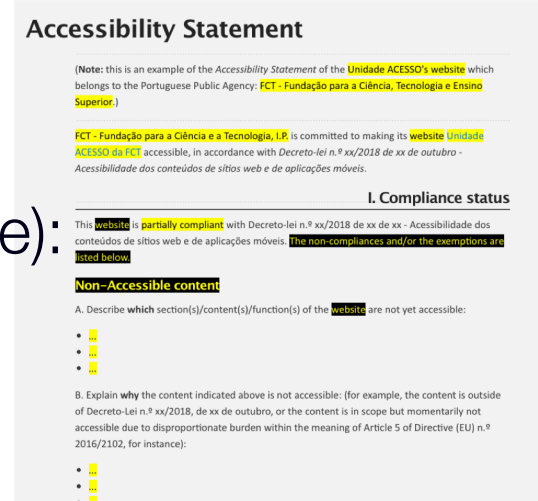


Accessibility Statement

(a place to public efforts / evidences / results)

- Writing the AS (Assistive Generation based on a form/template):
 - With the content based on the EU’s model
 - Made with the help of an Assistive Tool like WAI-Tools Generator

- Reading the AS (machine-readable)
 - to collect data:
 - to the monitoring exercise;
 - to produce metrics to our public “Live Accessibility DashBoard” (a comprehensive and understandable way of looking at ASs)

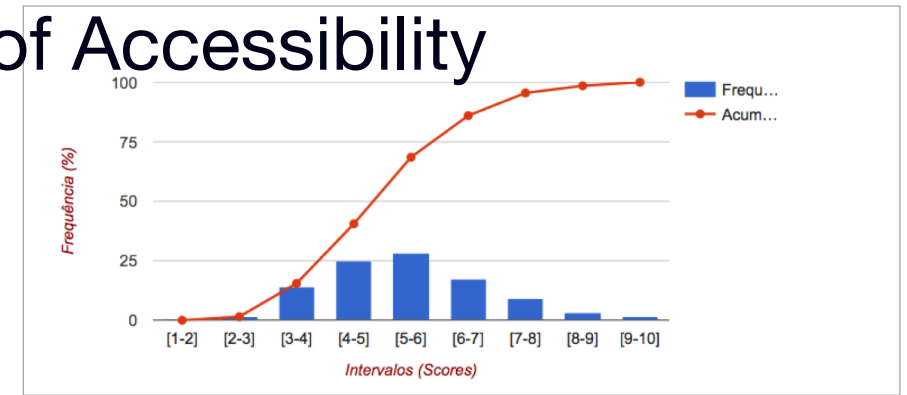


The Portuguese Observatory of Accessibility

Robust starting parameters:

- the importance of an harmonised Set of Rules.
 - Rules build with consensus processes like the rules of ACT Rules TF of W3C (Accessibility Conformance Testing). ACT Rules / Auto-WCAG Rules / WAI-Tools Project;
 - (...) and, when we speak about Rules, we need Authoritative Rules, Please!
- the importance of a “good” sample of pages/elements

- At the moment we are rebuilding our monitoring tools:
 - Observatory - a awareness tool to publish statistics of the different sectors
