Background Information on the Establishment of the new Correspondence Group on Strategic Plan

The Council Working Group for the Elaboration of the draft Strategic Plan and draft Financial Plan of the Union for 2016-2019 was established by Resolution 1358 adopted by the 2013 Session of the ITU Council. It held its first meeting on 18 June 2013. The next meeting is scheduled to take place on 13-14 November 2013. The due date for the publication of the draft structure of the Strategic Plan is 1 December 2013.

According to No. 62A of the Convention, Member states, Sector advisory groups and Sector members will contribute to the work of the drafting of the SP. The Secretariat may also present ideas for the consideration of the CWG. The CWG should also take into account the results of WTDC-14.

The Bureau of the TDAG established a Correspondence Group to work on ITU-D input to the ITU Strategic Plan 2016-2019. The Correspondence Group, which will communicate by electronic means and have a face-to-face meeting on 10 December 2013, will report to the forthcoming TDAG meeting (11-13 December 2013) on the results of its work.

Terms of reference for the Correspondence Group:

- Prepare an input for the elaboration of the draft Strategic Plan 2016-19 of the Union as regards the ITU-D Sector and report to the next TDAG meeting on 11-13 December 2013.
- Give due regard to the outcomes of the Regional Preparatory Meetings for the World Telecommunication Development Conference 2014 (WTDC-14) and take into account the work undertaken by the Council Working Group for the Elaboration of the draft Strategic Plan and draft Financial Plan of the Union for 2016-2019.

Composition of the Correspondence Group:

- The Correspondence Group on Strategic Plan is open to all ITU Member States and Sector Members.
- The Correspondence Group is chaired by Mr. Fabio Bigi (Italy).
- The Correspondence Group will use the mailing list itu-d-csp@itu.int.
- The Correspondence Group interactions may include e-mail exchange via the e-mail list or through electronic meetings.
- The Correspondence Group convener is its Chairman Mr. Fabio Bigi (Italy) and the Correspondence Group co-convener is the Chairman of TDAG, Dr. Vladimir Minkin (Russian Federation).

June 2013	Correspondence Group is established
August 2013	Consultation process is initiated with the membership
September 2013	A dedicated website will be provided with background material on the issue. This website will include reference to all ITU documents on the topic and contributions received from members.
September 2015	An e-mail reflector list is established for those who have indicated an interest in the topic.
October 2013	Initial input received from the membership is shared in a table on the dedicated website, organized by country in alphabetical order.
November 2013	Preparation of draft report providing the results of the work of the Correspondence Group.
December 2013	Finalise report at meeting on 10 December 2013, taking into account the results of the Council Working Group. The report is shared on the Correspondence Group's website and submitted to TDAG.
