On behalf of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), I am pleased to invite you to participate in the seminar "ITU and its role in ICT/telecommunication development in CIS" to be held in Moscow, Russia, from 6 to 8 July 2011 at the kind invitation of the Ministry of Telecom and Mass Communications of the Russian Federation.
