Mr. Wesam Sedik has more than 20 years of diverse experience in regulatory and economic aspects. Currently, He is currently sector head for technical office and strategic planning in the National Telecom Regulatory Authority in Egypt. During his career in NTRA, he played a vital role in many achievements on the national level including introducing several new services such as 5G, 4G mobile services, National broadband strategy, IMEI system to control illegal devices, e-KYC as a digital identity platform, e-SIM services, Wi-Fi calling, spectrum roadmap, etc.

Earlier, he was an executive director for market development (2020 – 2022), responsible for carrying out strategic planning, business studies and roadmaps for introducing new services in the Egyptian market and managing research & development activities and projects within NTRA.
