




INFOMED: National Information Network for Cuban public health professional





A network articulating to a set of people, institutions, means and resources collaborating in the service of health information of Cuba and of the world.



Infomed connects more than 3000 health professionals, in addition to the different institutions of the National Health System.






The development process of technical-scientific information services is based on a permanent theoretical and practical exploration, in open and multiuser environments, with capacity to respond to new demands of services.


The system has been fed by the advances made in this field in the last decade in Cuba and in the world, but at the same time, specific experiences have been integrated, systematized and shared.


