## WSIS Stocktaking: 2018-2019 Call for Update and New Entries

Publicly accessible **WSIS Stocktaking** database [www.wsis.org/stocktaking](http://www.wsis.org/stocktaking) currently with **10'000** entries and a growing community of more than 350.000 stakeholders;

**UN General Assembly** called for a close alignment between the WSIS process and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development: **WSIS Stocktaking is highlighting the contribution of 11 WSIS Action Lines to the achievement 17 SDGs;**

**ECOSOC resolution 2017/21** reiterates the importance of sharing best practices at the global level, and encourages all stakeholders to submit ICT-related projects and initiatives to the **WSIS Stocktaking platform.**

New Call for Submissions has been released in 2<sup>nd</sup> of July 2018, and the newly submitted activities will be reflected in the **WSIS Stocktaking Report 2019**, which will be released at the WSIS Forum 2019.
