Home to many diverse peoples and wildlife, the Kenyan savannah is monitored by community rangers who historically had to rely on a patchy network of radio and cell towers to stay connected.

An updated system combining the group communication capabilities of Iridium Extreme® PTT devices and updated mobile phones created a secure, well-connected network of rangers.

ZSL works to protect endangered species from threats such as poaching, illegal extraction and habitat loss in vast, remote, difficult to reach locations.

THE SOLUTION


Working with Iridium partners, ZSL developed a system that can capture data remotely and transmit it in near real time from any part of the world. This technology allows data to be gathered on a very large scale to complement scientists' manual data collection to monitor rare species and help anti-poaching efforts.



Ocean Profiling & Climate Monitoring





- Governments and environmental organizations deploy ocean profiling floats that rely on the Iridium[®] network to transmit critical data from anywhere in the world.
- Floats measure ocean currents, temperatures, and salinity to help track climate change and the impact on the oceans.
