At Cibervoluntarios Foundation we help thousands of people, free of charge, to understand and use technology to make a positive impact in their lives, regardless of their age, background, and digital knowledge. In 2024 we reached more than 100,000 people – a third of whom live in rural areas – averaging 180 weekly activities, most of which were in-person, thanks to our network of over 4,500 cybervolunteers.

The pioneer network in technological volunteering

Cybervolunteers are agents of change who bring technology closer to all of us, tailoring it to individual needs, helping to bridge the digital divide and promote a responsible and safe use of technology that promotes digital rights and citizen digital sovereignty.

More than 4,500 cybervolunteers are at the heart of socially conscious technology, reaching digitally vulnerable people.



Unique volunteering model


