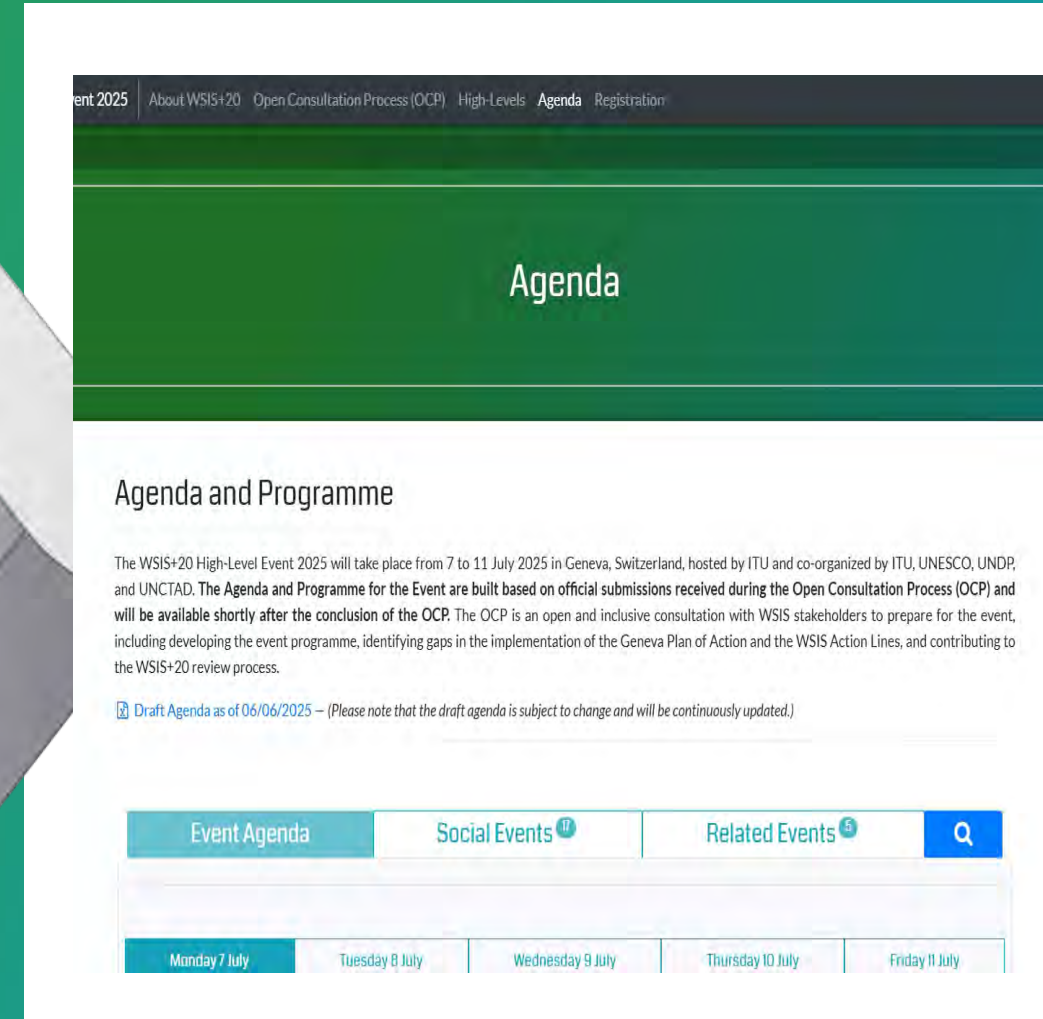

VISION FOR THE FUTURE OF THE WSIS PROCESS

- WSIS as the leading global platform for digital transformation.
- Establish WSIS follow-up as a permanent process.
- Ensure inclusive digital governance with equitable regulations.
- WSIS must continue bridging the digital divide.
- Keep WSIS adaptable to emerging challenges.
- Review WSIS every five years or less.
- Make WSIS more agile, inclusive, and influential.
- WSIS as a central hub for global digital governance.
- Move beyond declarations to concrete action.
- WSIS Forum and IGF continue to provide a multistakeholder platform.
- Strengthen WSIS as a driver of the global digital agenda.
- Strengthen open, multi-stakeholder dialogue.
- Continue collecting and sharing best practices through the WSIS Stocktaking Database, including the WSIS Prizes.
- Enhance data collection and impact measurement.
- WSIS as a reference for responsible digital transformation.
- Establish strong monitoring and accountability for WSIS.
- UNGIS must continue serving as an inter-agency mechanism on digital for development.
- Integrate GDC implementation into the WSIS Architecture.
- Leverage WSIS Forum to track GDC progress, including AI and data.
- Develop a GDC roadmap with clear roles and accountability.
- Promote inclusive, development-driven global digital cooperation.
- Align WSIS Action Lines with GDC and the evolving digital economy.
