NOTES

1 ITU-T Recommendation M.350 was published in Fascicle IV.1 of the *Blue Book*. This file is an extract from the *Blue Book*. 2 In this Recommendation, the expression "Administration" is used for conciseness to indicate both a telecommunication administration and a recognized operating agency.

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NUMBERING OF MASTERGROUPS WITHIN A SUPERMASTERGROUP

The position of a mastergroup within a supermastergroup is identified by a number in the series from 7 to 9 which refers to one of the numbers of the mastergroups constituting the basic supermastergroup.




FIGURE 1/M.350 Numbering of mastergroup within a supermastergroup

The numbering is shown in Figure 1/M.350.
