



ITU News questions for candidates

Candidates will be invited to answer the following questions regarding their candidacy.

How should ITU evolve to maintain relevance in today's world?

What are your top three priorities and how do you plan to achieve them?

What do you see as ITU's unique role in accelerating progress on the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals?

What has been your most important leadership achievement?

How have you built consensus amongst diverse stakeholders?

What else would you like to add?

The overall length of the responses to these questions must not in total exceed 1000 words (maximum).

Responses should be written in plain, concise language and in a style that is accessible, attractive and interesting to a general readership.

Abbreviations and acronyms should be kept to a minimum, and should be defined the first time they are used in the text. No footnotes, please.

An e-mail will be sent by ITU News to all candidates' personal email addresses with the questions on Tuesday, 2 October. Candidates will then be invited to submit answers to the questions by the <u>deadline of 23:59 CET on Friday, 5 October</u>.

Candidates will be strongly encouraged to submit their answers in the language they are most comfortable writing in, so long as it is one of the 6 official ITU languages.
