OPENING SESSIONS

Opening 1: OFFICIAL JOINT OPENING FORUM

Summary of moderator's statement

Launching the first of the week's Forum debates, to a packed auditorium which included government and industry leaders, Moderator Dr. Reza Jafari spoke of the critical role that the ICT industry has played in helping support global economic recovery, adding that the sector is well positioned to support future sustainable growth.

Summary of debate

Having weathered the storms of 2 crises over a decade, the ICT sector has more than demonstrated its resilience, indeed it has been a major contributor to jobs across all sectors. One of the main reasons for this is the ability of the ICT sector to support innovation across all sectors through, for example, information creation and sharing. Examples of this were available directly onsite, where thematic pavilions organized in association with other UN agencies showed how knowledge could be exchanged, for the benefit of all. A good regulatory framework is of course critically important – this topic that was explored by a number of panel sessions throughout the Forum.
