Transfers from Airport #1 (Using Airport Bus)

TTA is located in the downtown area and the center of Seongnam-City, approximately one hour from Airport.

In order to ensure smooth access from **Incheon International Airport** to TTA, we are pleased to provide some practical information.

1. Arrival at Incheon International Airport

When you're arrived at the airport, please pick up some useful information, e.g., City Maps, Tourist Information booklet at Information Center located inside of the airport building, please see the right picture.



- At near to Exit Number #8, you can buy the Ticket for Airport Limousine Bus from the Airport to **Bundang (or Seohyeon Station)**, the fare is 12,000 Won. Please also see the right picture.

※ Please Note that TAXI (from the Airport to TTA or downtown) is not recommended due to high cost. (over 70,000Won for Normal Taxi /120,000Won for Deluxe Taxi)



3. If you are sure to get the Ticket, then you can move to Airport Limousine **BUS STOP #8A** with getting out the Airport building through the Exit Number #7.



4. As soon as you're getting out from the Airport Building, you can find the bus to **Bundang (bus number is 5400)** at the Bus Stop #8A. The interval of the Bus is about 20-40 minutes. (more detailed information can be found at <http://www.airport.kr/airport/traffic/bus/busList.iaa?flag=E>)

※ Please don't be puzzled by the way of referring Bundang. Just focus on the way of pronunciation: Bundang, Boondang and Bundang can be used together.



5. When you're in time, you'll get right Airport Limousine Bus to Bundang (or Seohyeon Station). Please check the picture on your right. From the Airport to Bundang will takes about an 80 mins. **Please remember the name of bus stop, Seohyeon Station. It is the first stop right after departure from the Airport.**



※ If you come to Korea through Gimpo airport, you also can take **Airport Bus (# 5200) from Gimpo airport to Bundang (Seohyeon Station)**, the fare is 6,000Won. Please remember the name of bus stop, Seohyeon Station. Seohyeon Station is the first stop after departure from the Gimpo Airport.

Transfers from Airport #2 (Using Subway)

Using Seoul Metro you can get to any places in Seoul. Seoul Metro is inexpensive and usually pleasant but can be crowded in a certain time period. You can choose subway from Incheon Airport to TTA in case you are not with too much heavy luggage.

1. At **"Incheon International Airport station"**
 - Take "Airport Railroad Line"
 - Stop at "Hongik Univ. Station" (8 stops, 49 mins)
2. At **"Hongik Univ Station"**
 - Change GreenLine (Line2) (The next station is "Sinchon Station")
 - Stop at "Wangsimni Station" (12 stops, 22mins)
3. At **"Wangsimni Station"**
 - Change Bundang Line (The next station is "Seoulforest Station")
 - Stop at "Seohyeon Station" (18 stops, 42mins)

Four hotels are recommended by the host organization.

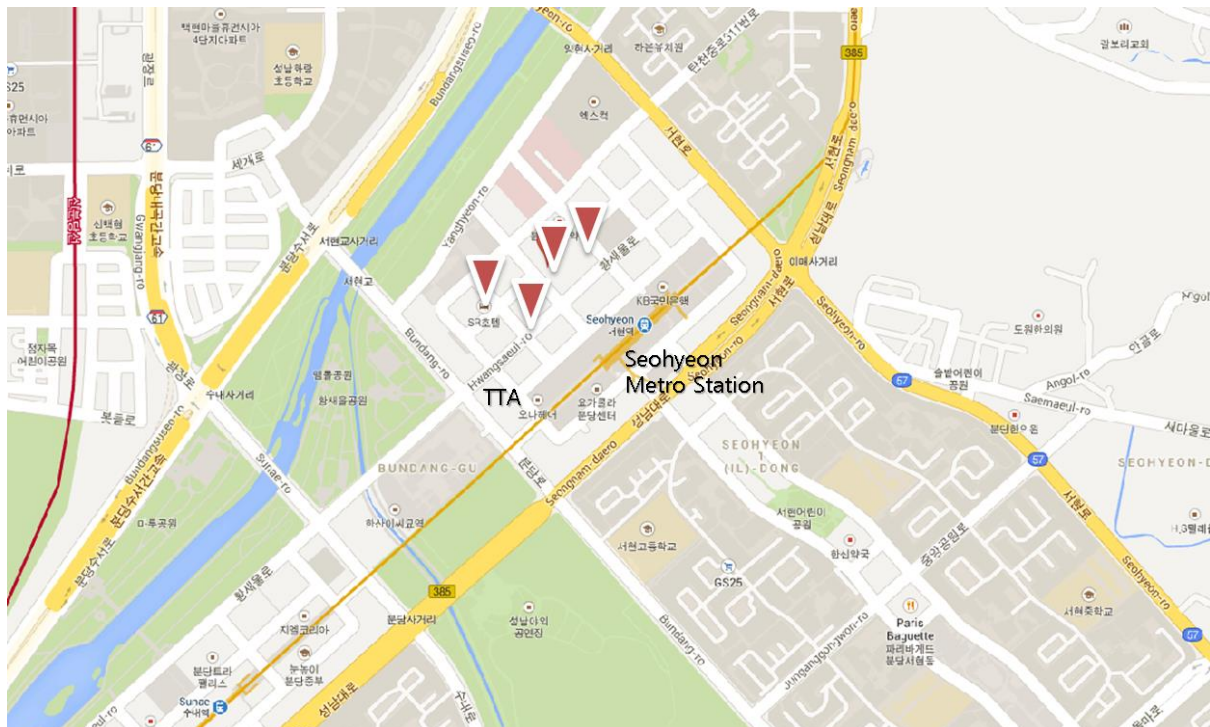
- Hotel rooms will be assigned on a first-come-first-serve basis, thus early reservation is recommended.

Visa

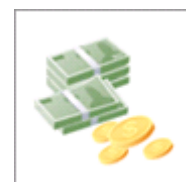
Foreign nationals entering the Republic of Korea are generally required to have a valid passport and a Korean visa. However, many are permitted visa-free entry for a limited time under certain conditions following the "Citizens of the Countries under the Visa Exemption Agreement" (http://english.visitkorea.or.kr/enu/GK/GK_EN_2_1_1.jsp). A tourist visa is acceptable for attending the Rapporteur meeting. A business visa is not required, as attending a Rapporteur meeting is not classified as a "commercial purpose" by Immigration in South Korea. If your visit to Korea includes other business activities, you may wish to consult with the South Korean Consulate in your country on specific requirements.

Currency & Exchange

The Korean currency unit is the WON (indicated ₩). Bank notes are ₩50,000, ₩10,000, ₩5,000, ₩1,000 bills and coin denominations are ₩500, ₩100, ₩50, ₩10. One US dollar is about ₩1,035 as of Aug. 2014. Money can be exchanged at Incheon International Airport, banks, and hotels. (<http://www.keb.co.kr/IBS/english/fx/rate/average/index.jsp>).



Electricity

The standard supply is 220 volts with AC/60 Hz.
The two following outlets are compatible with those available in Korea.
