TITLE : AMENDMENTS TO REC H.120 AND H.130

In the report of the meeting of the Working Party in Tokyo in December 1984 (Document #15) it is recorded that Part 2a of Rec H.120 should be revised. The report of the meeting of the Specialists Group (Document #14R) clarifies this by recording agreement to revise Part 2a "as necessaryto show that it is also applicable for intra-regional use within 525 lines and 1.5 Mbit/s region".

Recs H.120 and H.130 have been examined in the light of these decisions and this contribution proposes the detailed changes to the texts required to implement the agreement in Tokyo.

In Rec H.120, an additional sentence is required in the Introduction, to clarify the scope of Part 2a. The title of Part 2 requires amendment to improve the clarity and the title of Part 2a requires amendment to make it symmetrical with the title of Part 1. No changes are required in Rec H.130.

The amendments indicated above are the minimum required to implement the agreements concerning Part 2a at the Tokyo meeting. Details of the proposed changes to the texts are given in the Annex to this contribution.

## AMENDMENTS TO RECOMMENDATION H.120

1. In paragraph 3 of Introduction, add new sentence at end of paragraph which currently ends ".... 1544 kbit/s digital paths":

"This codec is also suitable for use within regions using the 525-line, 60 field/s television standard and 1544 kbit/s transmission."  $\Box$ 

- 2. Amend title of Part 2 to read:
  - " CODECS NOT REQUIRING SEPARATE TELEVISION STANDARDS CONVERSION WHEN USED ON INTERREGIONAL CONNECTIONS "
- 3. Amend title of Part 2a to read:
  - " A CODEC FOR 525-LINES, 60 FIELD/S AND 1544 kbit/s TRANSMISSION FOR INTRA-REGIONAL USE AND CAPABLE OF INTERWORKING WITH THE CODEC OF PART 1 "
