

Mandate

September 2004:

7th General Conference of Ministers mandated the CTU Secretariat to review the spectrum management policies and make recommendations for spectrum use in the region.

• April 2005

Concept paper for a comprehensive programme for harmonised Caribbean spectrum management policies and procedures was developed. The project would promote a regional environment of regulatory certainty which encourages private sector investment and ensures that spectrum is efficiently utilized






Mission
