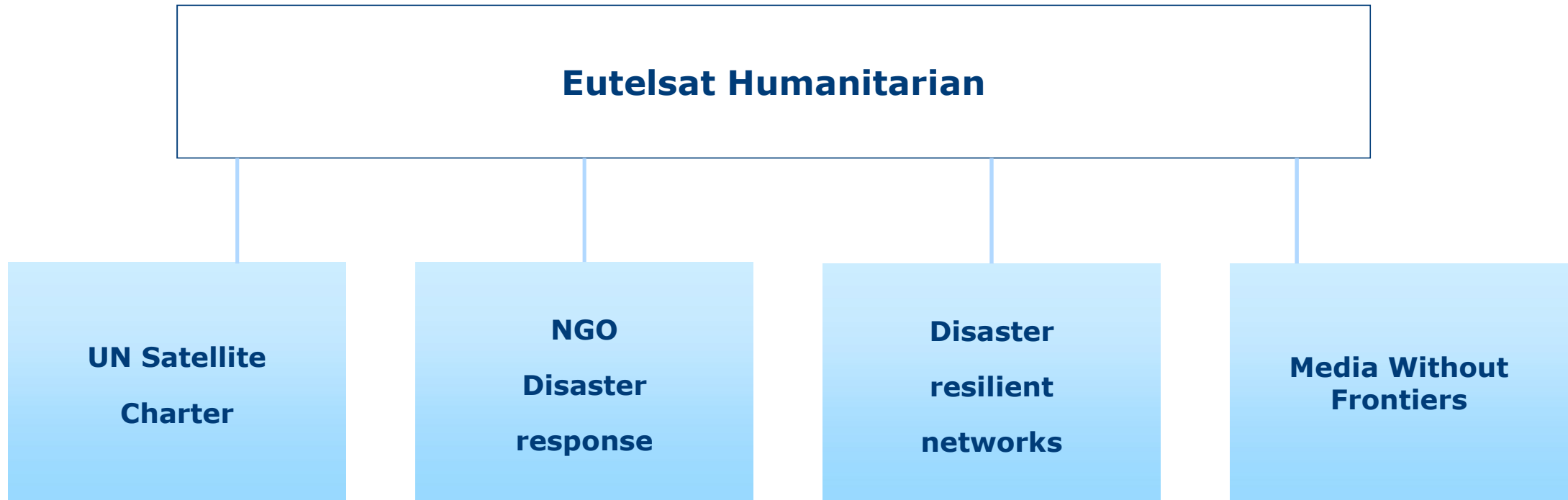

# CRISIS CONNECTIVITY CHARTER

- ✓ Eutelsat coordinated the crisis connectivity charter representing the satellite industry in negotiations with the UN for the first 2.5yrs.
- ✓ The charter has committed 9 satellite fleet operators to donate equipment and bandwidth covering the globe, ready to supply communications to the UN first responders
- ✓ The charter is the first such agreement between an industrial sector and the UN. The satellite industry is therefore ahead of logistics, Big pharma, ICT , etc. in its commitment to disaster relief.

# NGO DISASTER RESPONSE - NETHOPE

- /// Eutelsat donated 20 satellite terminals with free bandwidth to help with the Ebola outbreak in Sierra Leone in 2015. These terminals were used to supply communications to 20 remote hospitals and clinics.
- /// Eutelsat donated 15 satellite terminals with free bandwidth to help with the refugee crisis on 2016 helping to connect over 300,000 refugees.

Satellite only technology to allow regional/continental strategy and solutions to be implemented

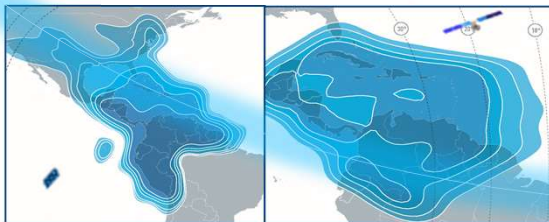


Lease connectivity to regional governments at times of disaster



Coordinated through regional agencies CDEMA

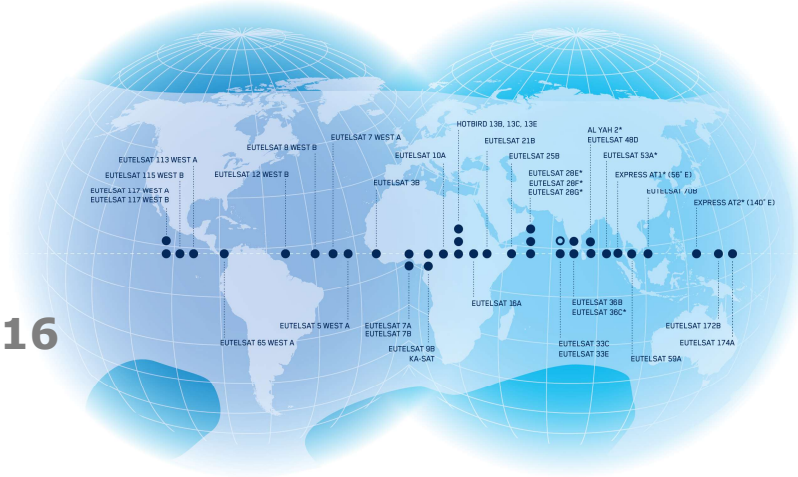
Eutelsat can partner with individual Government to manage & commercialize this regional resource to help close digital divide

- Promote engagement with the refugee population



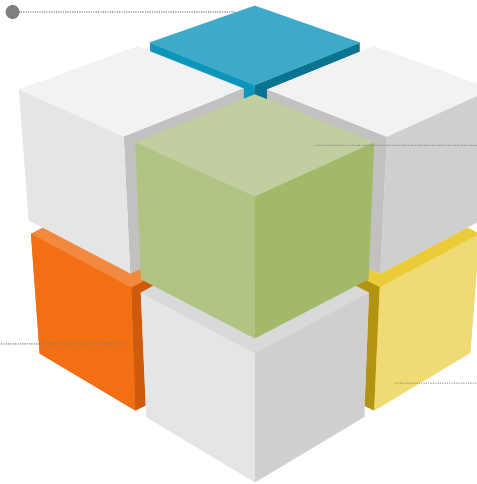
# MWF - PROJECT ELEMENTS



## 1 Live broadcast of TV channels onto smart devices

One way push service with Eutelsat patented technology Smart-beam

## 2 Dedicated educational library downloaded onto local servers for an integrated educational service across N. Africa & Middle East



## 3 On line training/education limited to specific agreed institutions

Connectivity limited to funder and government agreed educational sites only

## 4 E-Health

Tablets supplied to patients to allow access to TV service

Dedicated connectivity for remote consultations and patients' welfare

- All services offered to the host populations as well as refugees
- Capacity building in camps with local technical ambassadors
