Jeremy Fenton manages the ACMA Hotline for reporting offensive and illegal online content. The ACMA Hotline is responsible for investigating and actioning reports about online child sexual abuse material from the public, law enforcement and the International Network of Internet Hotlines (INHOPE) under the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*. The ACMA Hotline has a national reporting spine in place with all Australian law enforcement agencies and works closely with INHOPE members to ensure child sexual abuse material online is rapidly taken down and brought to the attention of police wherever it is hosted.

Mr Fenton has extensive experience with classification and content matters. Before coming to the ACMA, he spent seven years as a statutory appointee on the Australian Classification Board, including significant time as Senior Classifier and Deputy Director.
