The University of the South Pacific is the current Chair of the Council of Regional Organisations in the Pacific (CROP) Working Group on ICT. One of the Projects that she looks after is the Pacific Child Online Protection Project which comprises of stakeholders who have been doing work in this area over the past decade in the Region. She was the inaugural Chair of the Fiji Cyber Security Working Group when it was first commissioned several years ago and currently chairs the Legal Sub Committee of the Cyber Security Working Group.
