Statistical Facts: Source Census 2011

- According to the 2011 census, there are almost 26.8 million people with disability in India
- 14.9 million are men and 11.9 million are women with disability
 - 18 million live in rural India where as 8.7 million in the urban India
- Only 0.15% of the total population have succeeded in getting employed.
- The State of Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of disabled persons (16% of the total disabled in the Country) followed by Maharashtra (11%).
- The share of the disabled persons in the remaining 17 States/ UTs to the total population of disabled persons is less than 1%.

Current Employment Scenario for Persons with Disability

Type of Disability	Percentage of total disabled employees
Visual Impairment	9.87%
Loco-motor Impairment	70.57%
Speech and Hearing Impairment	8.26%
Mental Retardation	0.66%
Other disabilities	1.87%




Sarthak Skill Building Program for Person with Disabilities




